





18" Lone Star of Paradise Block

|  | White Floral | (1) 5" square (8) 2 3/4" squares |
|  | Aqua Tonal | (12) 2 3/4" squares (4) 2 3/4" x 5" rectangles (4) 3 1/4" squares |
|  | Red Floral | (4) 2 3/4" squares |
|  | White Solid | (16) 2 3/4" x 5" rectangles (12) 2 3/4" squares (4) 3 1/4" squares |

Block Construction

1. Use (4) 2 3/4" x 5" white solid rectangles and (8) 2 3/4" White Floral squares to make 4 Flying Geese units.

3. Use (4) 2 3/4" x 5" aqua tonal rectangles and (8) 2 3/4" white solid squares to make 4 Flying Geese units.

5. Sew together the White/Aqua Tonal Flying Geese units as shown.



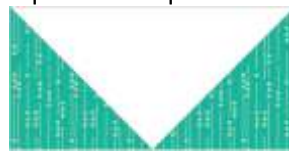

7. Sew together the remaining white floral flying geese and the remaining units made in Step 5 as shown. Make 2.

2. Use (4) 2 3/4" x 5" white solid rectangles and (8) 2 3/4" Aqua Tonal squares to make 4 Flying Geese units.

4. Use (4) 3 1/4" white solid squares and (4) 3 1/4" aqua tonal squares to make 8 half square triangles (hst's). Trim to 2 3/4".

6. Sew together 2 white floral flying geese units, 2 of the units made in Step 5, and the 5" white floral square as shown.



8. Sew together 2 aqua/white hst's, (1) 2 3/4" white solid square, (1) 2 3/4" aqua tonal square, (1) 2 3/4" red floral square, and (2) 2 3/4" x 5" white rectangles.



Make 4. Orient as illustrated.

9. Sew together one of the units made in Step 7, and two of the units made in Step 8 as illustrated. Make 2.



Make 2.

10. Sew together the units made in Step 6 & 9 to complete the block. It will measure 18 1/2".
