# # # # # # # # # # # # # # # # # # #	Green Geo Print	(2) 3 1/4" squares (4) 2 3/4" squares
X	Aqua Floral	(12) 2 3/4" squares (8) 2 3/4" x 5" rectangles (4) 3 1/4" squares
	Red Floral	(2) 3 1/4" squares (8) 2 3/4" squares
	White Solid	(8) 2 3/4" x 5" rectangles (20) 2 3/4" squares (4) 3 1/4" squares

Block Construction

1. Use the (2) 3 1/4" Green Geo Squares and (2) 3 1/4" Red Floral squares to make 4 HST's. Trim to 2 3/4".

3. Use the (4) 3 1/4" Aqua Floral Squares and (4) White solid squares to make 8 HST's. Trim to 2 3/4".

5. Use (4) 2 3/4" x 5" White solid rectangles and (8) 2 3/4" Aqua Floral Squares to make 4 Flying Geese units.

2. Use (4) 2 3/4" x 5" white solid rectangles, (4) 2 3/4" Green Geo Squares, & (4) 2 3/4" Red Floral Squares to make 4 Flying Geese units.




Make 4. Orient as illustrated.

4. Use (4) 2 3/4" x 5" Aqua Floral rectangles and (8) 2 3/4" white solid squares to make 4 Flying Geese units.




Make 4.

6. Sew together the star portion of the block as shown. Use the 4 Red Floral/Geo HST's, the 4 Red Floral/Geo Flying Geese, and (4) 2 3/4" white solid squares.




7. Sew together the Aqua Floral/White Flying Geese units as shown.

9. Sew together the star center and the 2 units made in Step 8.




11. Sew together (2) 2 3/4" White solid squares, (1) 2 3/4" Red Floral Square, (1) 2 3/4" x 5" Aqua Floral Rectangle, and 1 Aqua Floral/white HST. Make 2.



Make 2. Orient as shown.

13. Sew together the units made in Step 12 to the unit made in Step 9 to complete the block. It will measure 18 1/2".




8. Sew together one of the units made in Step 7, 2 Aqua Floral/White HST's, and (2) 2 3/4" Aqua Floral Squares. Make 2.





10. Sew together (2) 2 3/4" White solid squares, (1) 2 3/4" Red Floral Square, (1) 2 3/4" x 5" Aqua Floral Rectangle, and 1 Aqua Floral/white HST. Make 2.



Make 2. Orient as shown.

12. Sew together the a unit made in Step 7, a unit made in step 10, and a unit made in step 11. Make 2.
