






18" Star of Bethlehem Block

|  | White Floral | (8) 2 3/4" x 5" rectangles (4) 2 3/4" squares (6) 3 1/4" squares |
|  | Aqua Tonal | (10) 3 1/4" squares (4) 2 3/4" squares |
|  | Red Floral | (4) 2 3/4" squares |
|  | White Solid | (4) 2 3/4" x 5" rectangles (16) 2 3/4" squares (6) 3 1/4" squares |
|  | Small Floral | (2) 3 1/4" squares (4) 2 3/4" squares |

Block Construction

1. Use (4) 2 3/4" x 5" white solid rectangles and (4) 2 3/4" Small Floral squares and (4) 2 3/4" Aqua Tonal squares to to make 4 Flying Geese units.

3. Use (2) 3 1/4" White Floral squares and (2) 3 1/4" White Solid Squares to make 4 HST's. Trim to 2 3/4".

5. Use (4) 3 1/4" White Solid squares and (4) 3 1/4" Aqua Tonal squares to make 8 HST's. Trim to 2 3/4".



Make 8.

7. Use (2) White Solid 2 3/4" squares, (1) 2 3/4" White Floral Square, and (1) 2 3/4" Red Floral square to make a 4 patch unit. Orient as shown. Make 4



Make 4. Orient as Shown.

2. Use (2) 3 1/4" Small Floral squares and (2) 3 1/4" Aqua Tonal Squares to make 4 HST's. Trim to 2 3/4".

4. Use (4) 3 1/4" White Floral squares and (4) 3 1/4" Aqua Tonal squares to make 8 HST's. Trim to 2 3/4".



Make 8.

6. Use (4) 2 3/4" x 5" White Floral rectangles and (8) 2 3/4" White Solid squares to make 4 Flying Geese units.



Make 4

8. Sew together the center portion of the block using the units made in Steps 1-3.

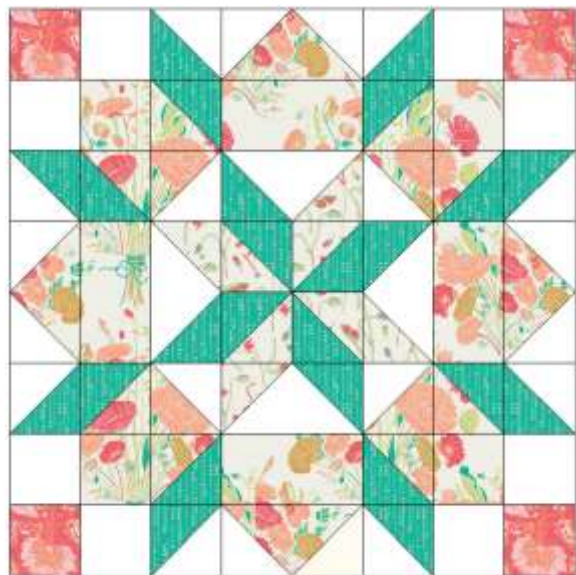

10. Sew 2 units made in Step 9 to the sides of the center portion.



12. Sew the units made in Step 11 to the top and bottom of the unit made in Step 10 to complete the block.



9. Sew together the units made in Steps 4-6 and a 2 3/4" x 5" White Floral rectangle as shown. Make 4 units.



Make 4.

11. Sew the units made in Step 7 to the sides of the remaining 2 units made in Step 9. Make 2.
